

Covid19 Village Updates

The effects of Covid19 on our Village are increasing daily. We are getting directives from the Federal Government, New York State and Tompkins County that we must follow. The Village Election has been postponed until April 28th.

The special joint meeting of the Board of Trustees and the Planning Board to continue the public hearing to discuss the Upland Heights project has been postponed at least until April 24th.

The Village Court has been ordered closed until at least mid-April. Any person requiring notice when the Court reopens should send their phone number and address to the Court by snail mail at 836 Hanshaw Road. When the Court is allowed to reopen it will send notice to those contacts.

We have been directed to maintain only essential staff and have as many people as possible working from home. Police and Fire protection will NOT be affected. They will remain available 24/7.

Our DPW crew will pick up garbage on the normal schedule, but they will NOT be collecting BULKY TRASH on Friday. Please do not put items at the curb this week. We have not yet decided if they will collect brush on April 3rd. Trash tags can be purchased at Tops or Wegman's.

To keep you and our Village staff safe, there will be no in-person contacts until further notice. Village Hall will not be accessible, however, we are still working and conducting essential business. Please contact us via:
